PROGRAM DATES:

- **November 15, 2013** – First day that fuel deliveries can be authorized or paid for through the program
- **March 17, 2014** – Deadline for deliverable fuel authorizations
- **May 1, 2014** – Last day that a household can apply for energy assistance
- **May 15, 2014** – Last day a utility heated household with a shut off notice can apply for energy assistance
- **May 30, 2014** – Last day that deliverable fuel vendors can submit bills
