To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Carrie Everetts, I am writing to you about the "New Law" in effect about prisoners such as Barbara Preston inmate # 311132, at York Correctional Institution, receiving FIVE (5) days off of their sentence a month for "Good behavior" or participating in programs for time off?!

My husband, Lee Everetts, who has a Traumatic Brain Injury amongst MANY other issues, does not receive 5 (FIVE) days off a month for GOOD BEHAVIOR or for participating in programs. Lee and our family have received a LIFE SENTENCE! Because of this assault on June 7th 2008, Lee was in a Coma for 6 (six) weeks where he spent the time in the Surgical Intensive Care Unit at Bridgeport Hospital with a tracheotomy and feeding tube. He was then transferred to The Hospital for Special Care in New Britain, Ct, where he spent two months in this rehabilitation hospital. After returning home, in a wheelchair with a daily visiting nurse, he had to go from being a perfectly healthy husband, father, and provider to being faced with everyday challenges that were once simple tasks for him.

Lee, myself and our two children Ryan and Emily find this to be "Very Disturbing" that a woman with 4 previous offences, who has been a menace to society time and time again, with a suspended license would be able to lessen her sentence because the "System doesn't have enough money to keep her in prison", which is where she belongs!! Our family has not received ANY monetary compensation from Barbara Preston, or her daughter Troy Smith whose car she was driving illegally at the time.

This is a Slap in the face to people who have worked hard there whole life, and because of Barbara Preston's "Problem" it has become our Problem for the rest of our lives!! She has RUINED my husband Lee, a 52 year old man who will Never be the same and my family's life because the system has failed.

My husband and family has received a LIFE SENTENCE; Physically, Emotionally, and Monetary.

The LEAST the State of Connecticut can do is have BARBARA PRESTON fulfill her Whole Sentence...

You, "Need" to reevaluate this law to protect people from drunks like this woman who are a Menace to Society.....
