



Did you know that Connecticut's Risk Reduction Credit Law allows violent felons - including those convicted of rape, manslaughter, kidnapping, or sexual molestation of a child under 13 -- to earn as many as five days off their prison sentences each month?



The good news is that a bill before the state legislature this Friday would end this dangerous program.

If you want to lend your voice to this cause, here's how you can help:

- Join us at the Legislative Office Building in Hartford on Friday, March 22 at 11:30 A.M. in Room 2B. Testify before the Judiciary Committee in support of Ending the Early Prison Release Program. Submit 45 copies of written testimony to Committee staff, no later than two hours prior to the start of the hearing in Room 2500 of the LOB. Sign-up for the hearing will begin at 9:30 A.M. and conclude at 11:00 A.M. in Room 2500.
