Dear Mr. Marinelli -----

I support the Senate Bill repealing the risk reduction credit program (SB123). I urge the Senate Judiciary Committee and our local (Bethel / Danbury / Redding) legislators to vote in favor of this repeal.

My rationale is simple. All I have to do is remember the violent rape, murders, and beatings of Dr. William Petit's family in the Cheshire home invasion on July 23, 2007.
