It has come to my understanding via Senator McLachlan (cc'd above) that Connecticut's Risk Reduction Credit Law allows violent felons -- including those convicted of rape, manslaughter, kidnapping, or sexual molestation of a child under 13 -- to earn as many as five days off their prison sentences each month.
