Dear Senators Gerranta and Representative Johnson and members of the Public Health Committee.

My name is Sandra Weller and I have lived in Unionville CT since 1984. I have also been a professor at the University of Connecticut since that time. I am writing to support Raised Bill 6592: An Act Concerning Certified Homeopaths.

I support this bill because I believe the citizens of Connecticut have a right to access to homeopathic care delivered by well-trained Homeopaths. The homeopathic education is comprehensive, and individuals who have completed it are well qualified to provide care to our citizens. Currently, access to homeopaths is limited in CT. There is an antiquated law from 1893 that says only medically trained people can practice homeopathy in CT. This is absurd, since there are many qualified homeopaths who do not have an M.D. degree but could be providing excellent level of care to our citizens. I would like to have the option to chose this kind of care for myself and my family and have been disappointed that access is so limited. I believe homeopathy is safe and affordable, and I would like CT to allow nationally board certified classical homeopaths (CCHs) to be able to offer their services in CT. The CCH is the highest level of achievement for a professional homeopathy and the credential is recognized worldwide. Please support this bill and urge your colleagues to do the same. Thank you for your consideration.
