We are writing in support of HB6015 repeal of 911 Ordinance.

As resident taxpayers in The City of New Britain Connecticut we support this repeal for the following reasons:

- 1: Our taxes already pay for emergency services including 911 services.
- 2: Restrictions on the number of calls to 911 for any reason, is a direct infringement on the 1st amendment.
- 3: Human life will be put at risk.

Residents are not comprehending this new ordinance and feel cautioned under any circumstances to limit the number of calls to 911. While this does not pertain to medical emergency calls, residents are confused. Just one mis-interpretation could result in the loss of life.

We budget annually for Police and Fire and EMT services. 911 is included in that budget. We understand the new ordinance with fees for 911 services over a certain number of calls is a revenue generating plan to help balance our city's budget deficit.
