

Dear Representatives,

I strongly urge you to pass legislation that tightens regulations on our assault weapon ban. I believe regulating dangerous weapons does not infringe on Second Amendment Rights. The right to Public Safety, which your committee is charged with requires getting military weapons out of the hands of civilians. It also requires a ban on the possession and sale of high capacity magazines. I would like to see a seven-round maximum, but would be satisfied with ten as a start. Universal background checks for all sales, including private sales, and a tightening of storage regulations are also called for.

Thank you for the hard work you do to help keep Connecticut citizens safe. The Governor's gun regulation proposals would go a long way to make us even safer.
