**AN ACT REQUIRING A TWO-THIRDS VOTE FOR ANY TAX INCREASE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 16 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 approval by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of each house
- 3 of the General Assembly for the enactment of any bill proposing a tax
- 4 increase.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require a two-thirds vote of the General Assembly before taxes can be raised in order to limit the tax burden on state residents and businesses.
