AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each all-terrain
- 2 vehicle to be registered through the state, except if such all-terrain
- 3 vehicle is operated solely on the property of the operator, and that the
- 4 registration fee for the all-terrain vehicle be thirty dollars annually, the
- 5 revenue from which shall be used by the Department of Energy and
- 6 Environmental Protection to maintain trails.

Statement of Purpose:

To require all-terrain vehicles to be registered through the state, and that the thirty-dollar registration fee be used by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to maintain trails.
