AN ACT CONCERNING AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That titles 14 and 38a of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 person who owns more than one private passenger motor vehicle to
- 3 obtain automobile liability insurance on behalf of such person and any
- 4 other named insureds or operators, rather than on each registered
- 5 motor vehicle as currently required, and to provide that such
- 6 insurance be rated based on the insured and named operators rather
- 7 than the number of registered motor vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a person who owns more than one motor vehicle to have automobile liability insurance rated and issued on the basis of the owner or operator, rather than on basis of the number of registered motor vehicles.
