**AN ACT CONCERNING MINIMUM LONGEVITY REQUIREMENTS FOR
UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require an employee to be
- 2 employed by their employer for at least thirty days before becoming
- 3 eligible for unemployment benefits.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that employees be employed for a period of thirty days
before they become eligible to file a claim for unemployment benefits.
