AN ACT CONCERNING HONORARY HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMAS FOR CERTAIN SENIOR CITIZENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to permit
- 2 local and regional boards of education to award honorary high school
- 3 diplomas to any person who (1) is ninety years of age or older, (2) has
- 4 lived in the state for the past fifty years, (3) attended a high school
- 5 under the jurisdiction of such board, and (4) withdrew from such high
- 6 school prior to graduation to find work or assist in the care of family
- 7 members.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow boards of education to award honorary diplomas to certain senior citizens.
