**AN ACT ESTABLISHING PEER REVIEW PANELS IN MEDICAL MALPRACTICE ACTIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That sections 52-190a and 52-190c of the general statutes be  
2 amended to establish a process by which peer review panels consisting  
3 of physicians, medical professionals and individuals outside the  
4 medical profession review claims of alleged negligence by a health  
5 care provider to determine whether there is probable cause that such  
6 claims have been made in good faith prior to the action being referred  
7 to mandatory mediation as provided in section 52-190c of the general  
8 statutes.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a peer review process for claims of alleged negligence by a health care provider.
