**AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
CONSUMER PROTECTION OF ALCOHOL-RELATED INCIDENTS  
INVOLVING INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 545 of the general statutes be amended to require a  
2 police department to provide notice to the Department of Consumer  
3 Protection when an investigation of the serious injury or death of a  
4 person under twenty-one years of age reveals that such person was  
5 served alcoholic liquor by a person or employee of a person who holds  
6 a permit authorizing the sale of alcoholic liquor to the public. Such  
7 notice shall be in writing on a form prescribed by the Department of  
8 Consumer Protection and shall contain the name of the seriously  
9 injured or dead person, the date and time of the alleged incident and  
10 the name and address of the implicated permittee.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To enable the Department of Consumer Protection to determine whether a permit authorizing the sale of alcoholic liquor to the public should be suspended, revoked or refused following the serious injury or death of a person under the age of twenty-one who was served alcohol by a permittee prior to said person's injury or death.
