**AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT
COMMISSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That section 9-7b of the general statutes be amended to provide that,
2 if a complaint is filed against an elected official, the State Elections and
3 Enforcement Commission shall disclose all documents associated with
4 the case against the elected official as a legal requirement,
5 notwithstanding any other provision of law, and that, if there is no
6 evidence of wrong doing, the commission shall dismiss the case after
7 thirty days from the filing of the complaint and that such
8 documentation cannot be used against the elected official under any
9 circumstance.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a more open complaint and investigatory process for the
SEEC.
