**AN ACT CONCERNING WORKERS' COMPENSATION EXPENSES
FOR CERTAIN POLICE SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to clarify that when a private
- 2 individual or entity contracts with a municipality to acquire police
- 3 services for events, such private individual or entity shall be
- 4 responsible for paying any workers' compensation expenses for the
- 5 police officers during the contracted period.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify that when private persons contract police services from a municipality, such private persons are legally responsible for paying any workers' compensation expenses for the officers incurred during the contract period.
