AN ACT WARNING STATE ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES OF THE CONSEQUENCES OF FRAUD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require that any
- 2 state-funded advertisements or public service announcements
- 3 promoting enrollment in state-administered assistance programs
- 4 include warnings to recipients and providers about the consequences
- 5 of fraudulently obtaining said assistance.

Statement of Purpose:

To alert recipients and providers of the consequences of fraudulently obtaining state-administered assistance thereby deterring fraud and instilling accountability.
