AN ACT REQUIRING THE DISPLAY OF HOUSE NUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2013*) (a) The owner of a
2 residential building shall affix numerals to such building indicating the
3 street number assigned to such building by the town or, if there is no
4 record of such assignment, the street number customarily used for
5 such building.

6 (b) The numerals used to indicate the street number of a building
7 shall be:

8 (1) Located on the exterior front of the building or on a post, sign,
9 mailbox or other device located between the building and the street;

10 (2) At least four inches in height;

11 (3) Of a color contrasting with the color of the background material
12 to which the numerals are affixed; and

13 (4) Positioned not less than four feet or more than twelve feet above
14 the surface of the ground.

15 (c) The location and size of the numerals shall be sufficient to ensure
16 their legibility when the building is viewed from one or more points
17 along the centerline of the street on which the building fronts between
18 projections of the sides of the building intersecting perpendicularly
19 with such centerline.

20 (d) If a building is set back more than one hundred feet from the
21 centerline of the street on which the building fronts, or if the numerals
22 would not be legible from such centerline because of an obstruction,
23 the numerals shall be affixed to a post, sign, mailbox or other device
24 located within ten feet of the driveway entrance to the building.

25 (e) Violation of any provision of this section shall be an infraction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require homeowners to prominently display the street number assigned to their home.
