**AN ACT ENABLING CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO INSTALL
TRAFFIC SIGNAL ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow any municipality
- 2 with a population greater than forty-eight thousand, upon approval of
- 3 such municipality's chief executive officer and legislative body, to
- 4 authorize the use of automated traffic enforcement safety devices to
- 5 enforce the provisions of section 14-299 of the general statutes,
- 6 concerning traffic control signals, at intersections within such
- 7 municipality.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase safety by reducing the number of red light violations.
