AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF FUNDING AND SUPPORT FOR HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED CARE FOR THE ELDERLY AND ALZHEIMER'S PATIENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commission on Aging shall
2 study (1) private sources of funding available to elderly persons and
3 persons with Alzheimer's disease in need of home or community-
4 based care, (2) the availability of programs funded by the state that
5 provide home or community-based care to elderly persons and
6 persons with Alzheimer's disease in need of home or community-
7 based care, and (3) the cost effectiveness of such programs funded by
8 the state. Not later than January 1, 2014, the commission shall submit a
9 report on such study, including recommendations on what state
10 programs should be expanded, to the joint standing committee of the
11 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to aging in
12 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To study funding available to elderly persons and persons with Alzheimer's disease for care at home or in the community.
