**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PORTABILITY OF LICENSES TO SELL
FOODS AT FARMERS' MARKETS IN THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize a vendor of
- 2 goods or food who has a license from a municipality or regional health
- 3 department to sell such goods or food at a farmers' market to sell the
- 4 same goods or food at any other farmers' market in the state during the
- 5 same calendar year subject to reasonable restrictions of the host
- 6 municipality.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage and enable vendors to participate in multiple farmers' markets.
