**AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRAINING AND AUTHORITY OF
CERTAIN CONSTABLES APPOINTED FOR FISH AND GAME
PROTECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to allow certain special
2 officers appointed as constables for fish and game protection to be
3 exempt from the police training requirements set forth in section 7-
4 294d of the general statutes, provided such constables complete a basic
5 police training course that is tailored to the duties of such constables
6 and administered by a police officer of the town who is certified under
7 section 7-249d of the general statutes. Further, to provide that such
8 constables may carry a firearm in the course of their duties if they are
9 certified by a firearms trainer of such police department and comply
10 with periodic recertification requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow certain constables to carry firearms in the course of their duties pursuant to section 7-249d of the general statutes.
