AN ACT CONCERNING AN INCREASED SALES TAX ON FOOD AND BEVERAGES SOLD AT RESTAURANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 219 of the general statutes be amended to increase the
- 2 sales tax on food and beverages at restaurants and bars by one per
- 3 cent, and distribute this increment to municipalities through the
- 4 municipal revenue sharing account.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a luxury tax on dining out to provide revenue diversification for municipalities.
