**AN ACT ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT PUBLIC HIGH
SCHOOL GRADUATES PROVIDE PROOF OF IMMUNIZATIONS TO
ENROLL AT A REGIONAL COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10a-155 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the requirement that Connecticut public high school graduates provide
- 3 proof of immunizations to matriculate or enroll as a full-time student
- 4 at a regional community-technical college.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement that students who graduate from a
public high school in this state and seek to enroll as a full-time student
or matriculate at a regional community-technical college provide proof
of immunizations.
