AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A HEALTHCARE FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF GRISWOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 five million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Public Health for the purpose of providing a grant-in-
- 6 aid to the United Community and Family Services for construction of a
- 7 healthcare facility in the town of Griswold.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funds to cover the construction costs of a new healthcare facility in Griswold sponsored by United Community and Family Services, to provide greater access to dental and healthcare services.
