**AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WITH A SUSPENDED
MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR
VEHICLE TO AND FROM SCHOOL OR WORK.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 14-111g of the general statutes,
- 2 concerning the suspension of the motor vehicle operator's license of
- 3 any person for any specified moving violation or suspension violation
- 4 occurring not more than thirty-six months after such person attended
- 5 an operator retraining program, be amended to allow such person to
- 6 continue to operate a motor vehicle for the limited purpose of
- 7 transportation to and from work or school for the duration of such
- 8 suspension.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow any person whose operator's license is suspended pursuant to subsection (c) of section 14-111g of the general statutes to operate a motor vehicle to travel to and from work and school.
