**AN ACT CONCERNING PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION
ON CERTIFICATIONS OF MARRIAGE AND DEATH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to ensure that certain
- 2 personally identifying information is not included in certifications of
- 3 marriage and death when requested by individuals other than the
- 4 parties to the marriage or, in the case of a certification of death, the
- 5 funeral home making arrangements for or the family members or
- 6 physician of the deceased person.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect against identity theft and to provide confidentiality while ensuring appropriate public access to vital records.
