**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF ANTIEPILEPTIC
MEDICATIONS TO SCHOOL CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-212a of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 certain unlicensed persons to administer antiepileptic medication to
- 3 students in school settings for treatment of the student's epilepsy.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow certain unlicensed persons to administer antiepileptic
medications to school children.
