**AN ACT PERMITTING REDUCTIONS TO THE MINIMUM BUDGET
REQUIREMENT FOR TOWNS THAT REGIONALIZE SERVICES,
ACHIEVE EFFICIENCIES AND LOWER COSTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That subparagraph (C) of subdivision (2) of subsection (f) of section
2 10-262i of the general statutes be amended to allow any district that
3 realizes new and documentable savings through increased intradistrict
4 efficiencies approved by the Commissioner of Education or through
5 regional collaboration or cooperative arrangements pursuant to section
6 10-158a of the general statutes may reduce such district's budgeted
7 appropriation for education in an amount equal to half of the savings
8 experienced as a result of such intradistrict efficiencies, regional
9 collaboration or cooperative arrangement for the fiscal years ending
10 June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow towns to reduce their minimum budget requirement for
education by encouraging school districts to regionalize services,
achieve efficiencies and lower costs.
