**AN ACT CONCERNING THE NONDISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN
INFORMATION RELATING TO PROBATION OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 870 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
2 a personnel or medical file or similar file concerning a current or
3 former probation officer employed by the Judicial Branch, including,
4 but not limited to, a record of a security investigation of such
5 probation officer by the Judicial Branch or an investigation by the
6 Judicial Branch of a discrimination complaint by or against such
7 probation officer, shall not be subject to disclosure under the Freedom
8 of Information Act to any individual committed to the supervision of
9 the Court Support Services Division.

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act certain information relating to probation officers that is requested by an individual under the supervision of the Court Support Services Division.
