AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUBJECT OF CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION COURSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-10b of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that physicians who have taken one continuing medical education
- 3 course in each of the required subject areas do not have to take
- 4 additional courses in those subject areas to satisfy the continuing
- 5 medical education requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To remove the requirement that courses be taken in the same five mandated subject areas every two years once the physician has taken one course in each of the subject areas.
