AN ACT CONCERNING CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION FOR PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-10b of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 physicians to take continuing medical education courses only in the
- 3 subject areas most relevant to professional practice and not require
- 4 physicians to repeat courses in any one subject area.

Statement of Purpose:

To make continuing medical education relevant and pertinent to the medical profession.
