**AN ACT EXPANDING ELIGIBILITY FOR NUMBER PLATES, MOTOR
VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSES AND IDENTITY CARDS
REFLECTING THE HOLDER'S STATUS AS A VETERAN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 14-20b and 14-36h of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to allow any person who served in the Connecticut National Guard or
- 3 a reserve component of any branch of the armed forces, regardless of
- 4 whether such person had active service in the armed forces, to obtain
- 5 (1) a special certificate of registration and a set of number plates
- 6 indicating such person's status as a veteran, and (2) a motor vehicle
- 7 operator's license or identity card indicating such person's status as a
- 8 veteran.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow any person who served in the Connecticut National Guard or
a reserve component of any branch of the armed forces, regardless of
whether such person had active duty service, to obtain a set of number
plates and a motor vehicle operator's license or identity card indicating
such person's status as a veteran.
