**AN ACT CONCERNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GENERAL
EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMAS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10-5 and 10-69 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 expand opportunities for attaining a high school diploma and ensure
- 3 that attaining a general equivalency diploma or adult education
- 4 diploma remains affordable to adults. Further to require the
- 5 Department of Education to have access to data relating to the general
- 6 equivalency diploma examination and relevant data associated with its
- 7 issuance.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand affordable opportunities for GEDs and adult education diplomas and to ensure that recent changes to the GED do not prevent the Department of Education from having access to the examination and related data.
