**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF INITIAL TEACHER  
CERTIFICATES TO GRADUATES OF THE CONNECTICUT  
ALTERNATE ROUTE TO CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-145b of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
3 *1, 2013*):

4 (a) The State Board of Education, upon receipt of a proper  
5 application, shall issue an initial educator certificate to any person who  
6 has graduated (1) from a four-year baccalaureate program of teacher  
7 education as approved by said state board, [or] (2) from a four-year  
8 baccalaureate program approved by said state board or from a college  
9 or university accredited by the Board of Regents for Higher Education  
10 or State Board of Education or regionally accredited, or (3) from the  
11 summer or weekend and evening alternate route to certification  
12 program administered by the Office of Higher Education, provided  
13 such person has taken such teacher training equivalents as the State
