AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTERED INTERIOR DESIGNERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 20-377l of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2013*):

3 (a) No person shall use the title "registered interior designer" or
4 display or use any words, letters, figures, title, sign, seal,
5 advertisement or other device to indicate that such person is a
6 registered interior designer in this state, unless such person (1) has
7 obtained a certificate of registration as provided in sections 20-377k to
8 20-377v, inclusive; or (2) is an architect licensed in this state.

9 (b) Any person holding a certificate of registration under this
10 chapter may utilize a seal. Such seal shall only include: (1) The name of
11 such person, (2) the words "Registered Interior Designer, State of
12 Connecticut", and (3) such person's registration number.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
