AN ACT CREATING THE CONNECTICUT MEDAL OF ACHIEVEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Adjutant General and
2 two officers of field grade or above, appointed by the Adjutant
3 General, shall constitute a board of officers to receive
4 recommendations, through military channels, for the award of the
5 medal of achievement to any member of the Connecticut National
6 Guard who has distinguished himself or herself through outstanding
7 achievement or meritorious service during military service ordered by
8 the Governor, including military service performed pursuant to
9 chapter 518 of the general statutes. A bronze oak leaf cluster shall be
10 issued in lieu of succeeding awards and a silver oak leaf cluster may be
11 worn in lieu of three bronze oak leaf clusters.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:
