**AN ACT REQUIRING A REPORT FROM THE BOARD OF REGENTS
FOR HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT REGARDING
ADMINISTRATORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2013*) (a) Not later than January 1,
2 2014, and biennially thereafter, the Board of Regents for Higher
3 Education shall compare (1) the salaries of the administrators at each
4 public institution of higher education within the Connecticut State
5 University System and the regional-community technical college
6 system with the salaries of administrators with similar responsibilities
7 at peer public institutions of higher education in the United States, (2)
8 the ratio of administrators to students and of administrators to faculty
9 at each public institution of higher education within the Connecticut
10 State University System and the regional-community technical college
11 system with the ratio of administrators to students and of
12 administrators to faculty at peer public institutions of higher education
13 in the United States, and (3) the salaries of the administrators in the
14 central office of the Board of Regents for Higher Education with the

15 salaries of administrators with similar responsibilities in the central
16 office of similar state university systems in the United States.

17 (b) Not later than January 1, 2014, and biennially thereafter, the
18 Board of Trustees for The University of Connecticut shall compare (1)
19 the salaries of administrators at The University of Connecticut with the
20 salaries of administrators with similar responsibilities at peer public
21 institutions of higher education in the United States, and (2) the ratio of
22 administrators to students and of administrators to faculty at The
23 University of Connecticut with the ratio of administrators to students
24 and of administrators to faculty at peer public institutions of higher
25 education in the United States.

26 (c) Upon completion of the biennial comparisons made pursuant to
27 subsections (a) and (b) of this section, the Board of Regents for Higher
28 Education and the Board of Trustees for The University of Connecticut
29 shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
30 general statutes, on such comparisons to the joint standing committees
31 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
32 higher education and appropriations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require a report on the comparisons of the salaries of administrators and the ratio of administrators to faculty and to students at the constituent units and central office of the Board of Regents for Higher Education with the salaries of administrators and the ratio of administrators to faculty and to students at peer public institutions of higher education and peer central offices of similar state university systems in the United States.
