AN ACT CONCERNING STATE-FUNDED CHILD CARE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 section 8-210 of the general statutes, any child day care facility or child
3 day care center (1) that entered into a contract with the Commissioner
4 of Social Services pursuant to said section 8-210 on or before July 1,
5 2012, for state financial assistance in operating a child day care facility
6 or child day care center, (2) that received a loan pursuant to section
7 10a-194c of the general statutes prior to July 1, 2012, and (3) whose
8 loan under said section 10a-194c is guaranteed pursuant to section 17b-
9 749g of the general statutes shall continue to receive state financial
10 assistance from the Department of Education, pursuant to said section
11 8-210, until the loan received pursuant to said section 10a-194c is fully
12 paid off by such child day care facility or child day care center.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To continue state financial assistance to those child day care facilities and child day care centers that entered into a loan agreement prior to July 1, 2012, and whose loans are guaranteed by the state.
