AN ACT CONCERNING THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF A MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OR USE OF A DIRT BIKE, ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE OR SNOWMOBILE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2013*) Any municipality may,
2 by ordinance, regulate the operation and use, including hours and
3 zones of use, of dirt bikes, and may prescribe a penalty for violation of
4 such ordinance in an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars.

5 Sec. 2. Section 14-390 of the general statutes is repealed and the
6 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

7 Any municipality may, by ordinance, regulate the operation and
8 use, including hours and zones of use, of snowmobiles and all-terrain
9 vehicles in a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of sections
10 14-379 to 14-390, inclusive, or any regulations adopted pursuant
11 thereto, and may prescribe a penalty for violation of such ordinance in
12 an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 2	<i>October 1, 2013</i>	14-390

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the maximum penalty that a municipality may charge an individual with respect to violation of an ordinance regulating the use or operation of a dirt bike, all-terrain vehicle or snowmobile.
