***RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE
CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE A TWO-THIRDS VOTE TO PASS
MUNICIPAL MANDATES.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section twelve of article third of the Constitution be amended
- 2 to provide that any new unfunded municipal mandate shall require a
- 3 vote of two-thirds of the members of each chamber of the General
- 4 Assembly to pass.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a two-thirds vote of each chamber of the General Assembly before a new unfunded municipal mandate may be passed.
