**AN ACT CONCERNING UNINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE FOR
BODILY INJURY TO A NAMED INSURED OR RELATIVE DURING THE
THEFT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 38a-336 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 uninsured motorist coverage to a named insured or a household
- 3 member of the named insured for damages arising from being struck
- 4 as a pedestrian during the theft of an insured vehicle.

To provide uninsured motorist coverage to a named insured or a household member of the named insured for damages arising from being struck as a pedestrian during the theft of an insured vehicle.
