**AN ACT REQUIRING STATE AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF INOPERATIVE LIGHTS ON THE STATE AND LOCAL HIGHWAYS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 236, 243 and 529 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 require state and municipal police officers who discover inoperative
- 3 lights along highways to provide notice of such inoperative lights to
- 4 the Department of Transportation, if such light is along a state
- 5 highway, or to the superintendent of highways and bridges or other
- 6 appropriate official of the town in which such light is located, if such
- 7 light is along a local street or road.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To improve safety on Connecticut's highways by facilitating the prompt replacement of inoperative lights that illuminate such highways.
