AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM ALLOWING CERTAIN STATE RESIDENTS TO OBTAIN A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR VEHICLE REGISTRATION REGARDLESS OF CITIZENSHIP OR IMMIGRATION STATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow the Commissioner of
- 2 Motor Vehicles to establish a program enabling certain Connecticut
- 3 residents to obtain a motor vehicle operator's license, commercial
- 4 driver's license or motor vehicle registration regardless of such
- 5 residents' citizenship or immigration status.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote public safety and to increase state revenues by ensuring that all Connecticut drivers are licensed and trained.
