AN ACT ALLOWING ANY PERSON ACCEPTED INTO THE FEDERAL DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS PROGRAM TO OBTAIN A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to allow any person
- 2 who has been accepted into the federal government's deferred action
- 3 for childhood arrivals program to obtain a motor vehicle operator's
- 4 license in accordance with section 14-36 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit any individual granted federal deferred action status to legally operate a motor vehicle in Connecticut.
