**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING
RESTRICTIONS IN AREAS RESERVED FOR PERSONS WHO ARE
BLIND OR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require any local police
- 2 officer who, in the course of the officer's duties, observes a motor
- 3 vehicle parked in violation of section 14-253a of the general statutes, in
- 4 an area reserved for exclusive use by persons who are blind or persons
- 5 with disabilities without displaying a special license plate or placard,
- 6 to issue either a written warning or a summons for commission of a
- 7 violation of said section.

Statement of Purpose:

To require police officers to issue either a written warning or a summons for commission of a violation of the handicapped parking statute.
