AN ACT PROHIBITING CANDIDATES CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES FROM RECEIVING A GRANT FROM THE CITIZENS' ELECTION FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 157 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit a
- 2 candidate who has been convicted of a crime related to their state
- 3 government service from participating in the Citizens' Election
- 4 Program.

Statement of Purpose:

To maintain the integrity of the Citizens' Election Program.
