AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE TO BE FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESCHOOL PROGRAM TUITION AT INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10-264l and 10-264o, as amended by sections 11 to 13,
- 2 inclusive, of public act 12-1 of the December special session, be
- 3 amended to repeal the requirement that local and regional boards of
- 4 education be responsible for paying any tuition charged for students
- 5 enrolled in a preschool program offered at an interdistrict magnet
- 6 school operated by a regional educational service center and that the
- 7 state be financially responsible for such preschool program tuitions.

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal the requirement that towns are responsible for paying preschool program tuition at interdistrict magnet schools and to require the state to pay for such preschool program tuitions.
