**AN ACT CONCERNING INDECENT EXPOSURE DIRECTED AT A
PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) designate public
2 indecency under section 53a-186 of the general statutes as public
3 indecency in the second degree, and establish a new class D felony
4 crime of public indecency in the first degree when the actor commits
5 public indecency in the second degree knowing that such conduct will
6 be viewed by a person under sixteen years of age, and (2) require those
7 convicted of public indecency in the first degree to register with the
8 Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection as a sexual
9 offender.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish that public indecency committed knowing that such
conduct will be viewed by a person under sixteen years of age shall
constitute a class D felony, and require those convicted of the offense
to register with the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public
Protection as a sexual offender.
